April income - \$3.4M YTD - \$339M

The net income for the 11-month period is currently \$58K after running a deficit from the previous year.

Cash collections for the year \$33M – almost \$30M less than the previous year which is reflected in patient revenue.

Days of cash on hand is strong - 160 days

Mr. Mirzabegian stated the financials for fiscal year 2020 should be closing at a positive position. The hospital's audit process for fiscal year 2019 is set to start soon.

Meetings with OSHPD and the Health Department should provide a start date for the construction of the temporary modular for the emergency department.

The hospital is actively working to bring new programs. A new thrombectomy program is in the works to become a comprehensive stroke center. AVH is also embarking on creating an inpatient hospice program.

Physician recruitment is another high priority for the hospital. Recruitment for neonatologists, cardiac surgeons, vascular and general surgeons are in progress.

The SEIU Union contract will be completed next week to then be ratified by the board.
